We hereby confirm that copper articles supplied by Astrup are in general not in conflict with the above-mentioned European Directives.

This means that the articles do not contain any of the below mentioned chemicals to such an extent that they are unusable for RoHS critical end products.

- Cadmium (Cd) and its compounds
- Lead (Pb) and its compounds
- Mercury (Hg) and its compounds
- Chromium (Cr (VI)) and its compounds
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE, e.g., PentaBDE and OctaBDE)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

The scope of this Certificate of Conformity is that the main part of the alloys sold by Astrup comply with RoHS I, RoHS II and RoHS III.
